

## OFF-LICENCE FORM 10

Sections 17 to 20 and 64, Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012

PURSUANT to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 (the Act), Huia Estate Vineyards Limited (the licensee) is authorised to sell alcohol on the premises situated at 22 Boyces Road Rapaura, Marlborough District and known as "Huia Estate Vineyards Limited", to any person for consumption of the premises and to supply alcohol free, as a sample, for consumption on the premises.

The authority conferred by this licence must be exercised through a manager or managers appointed by the licensee in accordance with Subpart 7 of Part 2 of the Act.

- No alcohol is to be sold or delivered on Good Friday, Christmas Day or before 1.00 pm on Anzac Day. No alcohol is to be sold or delivered on Easter Sunday unless the alcohol is grape wine or fruit or vegetable wine

- 0 Alcohol may be sold or delivered on the following days and during the following hours: Cellar Door - Monday to Sunday 10:30 am to 5:00 pm

No alcohol sold is to be delivered on Good Friday, Easter Sunday, Christmas Day, or before 1.00 pm on Anzac Day, delivered is restricted: Remote sales - at any time on any day however the days and hours within which alcohol that has been sold may be

or at any time after 11.00 pm on any day and before 6.00 am on the next day.

The licensee must ensure that the provisions of the Act relating to the sale and supply of alcohol to prohibited persons are observed and must display appropriate signs adjacent to every point of sale detailing the statutory restrictions on the supply of

  The licensee, when conducting phone, mail, internet sales (remote sales) must ensure that all the requirements under Section 59 of the Act relating to remote sales are complied with
